Complete Economics 102B and at least 2 lecture courses most relevant for the proposed topic of the honors thesis. These can be included in the basic 80 units and should be completed by the end of the junior year.

Write an honors thesis in the senior year for one to ten units of credit (Econ 199D) under the direction of a member of the department or its affiliated faculty. Units of 199D or 139D do not count in the computation of the GPA requirement for honors. However, the requirement for Econ 101 may be replaced by 5 units of credit for the honors thesis to leave honors students with a total of at least 85 units overall.

Other field or elective courses may be substituted for those you and your advisor have indicated on this form. However, it is the student's responsibility to make sure that the requirements for the major are completed.
